The children have also been busy caring for growing plants outside, as well as their own bodies in warmer weather.

Key vocabulary:

lifecycle - egg -metamorphosis chrysalis - butterfly - adult baby - child -incubator - duckling beak - pond - lake - marsh

grow up -get older -crawl -spin flap - crack - hatch - waddle paddle

gentle - delicate - symmetrical - webbed (feet)

Literacy Activity

The children have been developing their early phonics skills by playing lots of games to help them identify the initial sounds of words. It is important to model sounds to children correctly. Our focus is on listening and hearing sounds in words as this is the skill your children will need to blend (put together)and segment (take apart) words when they start primary school.


